

- know-how and technical tools to coordinate and harmonize research and surveillance for Member States in key EU health policy areas.





# European Health Information System

The goal of such an EU health information system is to

- foster a common health information strategy including aspects of good governance,
- develop methodologies for establishing health information priorities and reducing health information inequality,
- develop coherence and compatibility between national systems and
- coordinate existing EU health information infrastructures and research activities.
